Is the Toronto Montessori Institute (TMI) still admitting students for Summer (July) and Fall (September) 2020?

Yes – the Registrar's office continues to process applications and make offers of admission. To submit your application go to [APPLY](#).

We also understand that some students require additional flexibility in meeting deadlines as a result of disruptions to schooling or exams due to COVID-19. TMI is committed to working with any students who may need extra time in order to complete their application.

Is TMI still admitting students?

Domestic Applicants – Yes, we continue to make offers of admission for the Summer (July) and Fall (September) 2020 Sessions.

International applicants – Yes, we continue to make offers of admission for the Summer (July) and Fall (September) 2020 Sessions.

Is the Summer (July) Session taking place?

Yes – TMI is planning for the delivery of programs and courses for Summer 2020. During Ontario's emergency order, Summer 2020 programs will be delivered via Alternative Training Measures (synchronous and asynchronous learning). While we are currently offering alternative training measures, they will expire following notification by local public health officials that there is no continuing risk of contracting COVID-19 by attending the Toronto Montessori Institute.

Is the Fall (September) Term taking place?

Yes – The Fall 2020 term is scheduled to start on September 9, 2020, and we look forward to welcoming all admitted students in September! Any updates will be made through e-mail and our website, and you are welcome to review the [Course Dates and Fees](#).

When can I expect a decision on my application?

The typical processing time is two to four weeks once all required documents are in the possession of the admissions team. We continue reviewing applications into early June for the Summer session and early August for the Fall Term.

Can I accept my offer of admission after the deadline stated on my Letter of Acceptance?

We encourage you to accept your offer by the deadline in your Letter of Acceptance to guarantee a spot in your program of interest. No registration deposit is required at the time of accepting your offer. Document Submission

Is TMI receiving documents by mail or courier?

We are accepting mailed documents. Please note that there may be delay in responding as we are working remotely. Couriered documents cannot be accepted at this time.

How should I submit my documents?

I will not be able to submit my documents by the required deadline. Will I lose my offer of admission?

I am a current student in Canada, how can I extend my status if my study permit will soon expire?

You can apply online to extend your stay in Canada. **If you're a student**, you have 2 options:

1. If you're no longer studying, you can
 - apply to change your status to visitor, as long as your study permit has not expired
 - find out **how to extend your stay in Canada as a visitor**
