TMI Summer Mode Diploma Programs Starting July 4, 2016

Infant Toddler (Birth to Three Years) Diploma Program

The Infant Toddler course is an intensive summer mode program. The course runs for 7 weeks, through July and August, preparing you to complete your observation and practice teaching between September and June.

Early Childhood (Ages 2 ½ through 6 Years) - Internship

The program begins with an intensive 8-week academic session. Classes which are held Monday through Friday, 9:00 am to 4:00 pm focus on Montessori theory, practice and curriculum implementation. You are immersed in learning about the Montessori experiential approach to education through lectures, demonstrations and practice with Montessori materials.

Upon successful completion of the summer session, you begin the practicum component of your education. You acquire valuable teaching experience as you assume increasing responsibilities working 5 days a week from September until June in an approved Montessori classroom.

Elementary (Ages 9 through 12 Years)*

TMI's Elementary I & II summer mode course provides a full range and vision of the elementary aged child for Montessori teachers wishing to broaden their Montessori understanding. The summer mode course is open to candidates holding both a university degree and a Montessori ages 6 through 9 diploma.

The 2016 summer session focuses on the ages 9 through 12 component. You will have until December to complete all course components.

*A diploma is awarded only upon successful completion of both the ages 6 through 9 and ages 9 through 12 components.
