- In the case of the Early Childhood Diploma Courses and Infant Toddler Diploma, special consideration will be given to those who have not attained an undergraduate degree but have other post-secondary education **and** experience working/volunteering with children.

Please note an official transcript of all university/college and graduate level work must be provided.

- For part time and summer mode programmes, preference is given to those who have or who are currently working in a Montessori environment; and
- A completed application form;
- A current resume;
- Three letters of recommendation, preferably one academic, one business and one from a person of long-standing acquaintance;
- A written report of an observation in a Montessori classroom at the age level of the course to which the applicant is applying;
- A Vulnerable Sector Screening obtained within six months of the application;
- A non-refundable application fee of \$150.

Once TMI has received the complete application package (the above items), candidates must pass:

- An interview process which includes:
- An English assessment paper.

Upon acceptance students must submit:

- A completed health form;
- A recent photograph
- A registration fee.

Once TMI has received your complete application package, you will be contacted for an interview. Applicants will be required to write an English assessment paper at the time of interview. The interview process takes approximately 2 hours.

Cancellation of a Course: TMI reserves the right to cancel a course three weeks prior to its commencement. All monies paid by the applicants towards the courses will be refunded.
